



## General Manager's Update

### Temporary Mandatory Face Coverings Bylaw

On Wednesday afternoon, the City of Edmonton passed a Temporary Mandatory Face Mask Coverings Bylaw to take effect as of Saturday, August 1<sup>st</sup> (to review the Bylaw, [click here](#)). The Edmonton Petroleum Golf & Country Club is excluded from this Bylaw as we are located within Parkland County. **However, for the safety of our members and employees the Board of Directors and Management recommends and encourages all members and staff to wear a mask upon entering and when travelling around the Clubhouse as of August 1<sup>st</sup>.** A mask must cover your nose, mouth, and chin.

#### MASKS ARE RECOMMENDED:

- Upon entering the Clubhouse.
  - When travelling throughout the Clubhouse, including in all hallways and common areas.
  - In all locker rooms and washrooms.
  - In the Golf Shop.
  - If you must enter any of the offices.

We encourage members to bring and wear their own masks to ensure optimal comfort. A limited number of complimentary disposable masks will be available for members who require them upon entry into the Clubhouse. The Bylaw excludes the use of face masks for any outdoor activity and while dining in designated seating areas. With these two exemptions in mind, this should prove to have a very minimal impact on our enjoyment of the golf course and our dining facilities for the remainder of the season.

Ultimately, as a member, it is still your choice to when and where you use a face covering while travelling around the Club. However, as of August 1<sup>st</sup>, you will see our employees begin to use masks in all indoor areas in the Clubhouse, except for in the offices while doors are closed.

Thank you for continuing to support the Club's COVID-19 efforts. Our team is doing their best to ensure the safety of everyone at the Club and your patience, understanding and respect of our team is most appreciated. Creating a safe and enjoyable experience for members and employees is vital to our ongoing success through this difficult time.
