### Face Coverings Mandatory at EPGCC

Good Morning Petroleum Club Members:

As a Club and a community, we continue to navigate our lives through this “new normal” as it relates to the impact COVID-19 has had on our daily lives. I would like to thank our Shareholders and membership for their continued support as we are continually adapting to comply with AHS recommendations and provide our members and staff with a safe environment. As we move into the school months, along with cases rising in Edmonton, we want to make sure that we continue to be diligent with procedures and protocols so we can finish the year strong while we enjoy as much golf as possible.

**Starting immediately face coverings will be mandatory** in all common areas of the clubhouse. This includes the locker rooms, Golf Shop, and hallways. Once you are outside or seated at your table in one of the dining areas, you are then able to remove your face covering. As a reminder, if you get up from your table, you must reapply your face covering.

We have also noticed that many people have developed cohorts that they golf with on a regular basis; this naturally happens every year, however, this year we just have a fancy name for them. I would remind everyone to continue your persistence with all protocols that we have maintained up to this point. Sometimes we find that we get comfortable in certain situations, but as we all know, we are still living with COVID and must remain constant with our daily routines we have developed to protect ourselves and everyone around us. A few things to remind everyone of:

- While in the restaurant be sure to keep groups at a maximum of six people per table.
- Do not move any tables in the restaurant or patio – they are placed and spaced accordingly.
- Maintain hand-washing – outside of our excessive use of hand sanitizer, be sure to wash your hands regularly.
- Social Distancing should be practiced whenever and wherever possible – avoid hugs, handshakes, and any close contact with anyone outside of those who you live with.
- Your Health/Our Health – if you feel any symptoms such as cough, headache, fever, runny nose or difficulty breathing, please for your safety and the safety of your fellow member and our staff, stay home.
