



Important GM Update

Golf Course Opening

Good Afternoon Members:

We are very excited to announce that the Golf Course will officially open at **noon on Thursday, April 22nd**. The next few days will be extremely beneficial for our Turf Care team and their preparation of the course. Being still early on in our season, the turf is still quite dormant, and frost is still in the ground. Prior to play, all areas of the course will see a proper cut, remaining downed trees/debris will be cleaned up out of high play areas, bunker pallets removed and worked, and hopefully, we will have full irrigation control. Tee Time **Reservations will begin on Tuesday, April 20th at 8am** and then follow the Spring Tee Time/Reservation schedule ([click here](#) to view).

It is very important to all of us that we continue to be able to play Golf during the COVID Pandemic. Therefore, we ask that everyone abide by all safety procedures and recommendations, such as social distancing and washing/sanitizing hands often. In the event that you are not feeling well or are exhibiting any COVID- 19 symptoms, stay home. This will help ensure both the safety of your fellow member and P Club staff alike.

Golf Protocols

- Currently, the tee sheet is open to members only (no Guest play at this time - stay tuned for future updates).
- All players must check-in with the Golf Shop prior to their round or going to the practice facilities.
 - Booking practice times will no longer be required (once course opens) however, you must check-in with the Golf Shop prior to practicing for contact tracing purposes.
 - The range will open 30 minutes prior to the first tee time.
- Maximum of 5 patrons in Golf Shop at one time.
- Power carts- Maximum 2 carts per group, recommended that a mask be worn when riding with anyone outside your household.
- Club storage will be offered; however, club cleaning will not be available at this time. Bags can be returned to black bag rack outside of the golf shop after your round or practice.
- Power carts and push carts are to be returned to the sanitization area next to the cart barn (same location as 2020 season) after your round.
- Do not touch the flags, please use the Pin Caddy to retrieve your ball once holed.
- Stay distant from player partners as often as possible.

F & B Protocols

- The Restaurant will be open for patio service and curbside pick-up only. Our full [2021 Menu](#) is available for ordering.
 - Hours of Operation are as follows:

- **Presently:** 11:30am – 7:30pm
- **April 22nd-23rd:** 11:30am – 10:00pm (last call) or earlier if all players are off the golf course.
- **April 24th and beyond (until indoor dining can resume):** 11:00am – 10:00pm (last call) or earlier if all players are off the golf course.
- There are multiple unique table and seating arrangements on the patio to accommodate AHS guidelines. Tables and chairs cannot be moved.
 - At this time, you are still only permitted to dine at the same table with members of your household. However, in addition to patio tables, we have set-up patio chairs with side tables and positioned them far enough apart to allow for seating with non-household members.
- Patio heaters are ready and plentiful.
- If you are coming to the clubhouse specifically to dine, please call ahead to make a reservation – this will ensure you have a spot to dine.
- **Concession Hours (Weather dependent):**
 - April 22nd- 25th: 11:30am – 7:30pm
 - Starting April 26th, the concession will open 1.5 hours after the first tee time and stay open until the final group has made the turn.

As always, we will continue to abide by all AHS protocols and guidelines and monitor all aspects of the business and make any necessary adjustments that best serve our members and employees while monitoring our operational finances. This is and will continue to be a very fluid situation that could change at any time. Thank you for your patience and understanding. We ask that you stay up to date with any club communications as it is the best way to stay informed. We look forward to seeing you back on the course (from a safe distance)!
